

ORDINANCE NO. 32.SEC.10.21

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT A VIOLATION TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE OVER AND UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE TOWN OF OAK RIDGE WITH A BLOOD ALCOHOL CONTENT OF .1% OR MORE. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK RIDGE, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS.

- 1. That no person shall drive or operate a motor vehicle on or within the public streets and alleys of the Village of Oak Ridge when an individual has a blood alcohol concentration of 0.10 percent or higher by weight as used in this ordinance, per cent by weight of alcohol in the blood shall be based upon grams of alcohol per one hundred milliliters of blood and may be shown by chemical analysis of the person's blood, breath, saliva or urine. for the purpose of deter-mining the alcoholic content of the person's blood under this ordinance, the test shall be conducted in accordance with the provision of Chapter 577 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, 1969. and as thereafter amended.**
- 2. Violators of this ordinance may face a fine ranging from \$5.00 to \$100.00, imprisonment in county jail for 1 to 30 days, or both.**
- 3. Any ordinances that conflict with this ordinance are repealed, but only as far as the conflict exists.**
- 4. This ordinance takes effect upon passage and approval.**
